Judith Leslie has over 25 years' experience in the Graphic Arts field, primarily in printed and presentation materials. In 1992, she established her own freelance design studio. Judith works closely with many diversity and training companies, creating projects for their internal needs and developing support materials for their national and international clientele. Previously, she spent eight years with a central FL printing house as an artist/pre-press technician. For nine years, she worked with the Alachua Co. Library District in Gainesville, FL, and served as resident artist in the Children's Department, producing large-scale room decorations, puppet shows, and printed materials. Judith also served as a Recreation Specialist for the U.S. military in Germany, where she was in charge of a full-service arts and crafts shop.

Judith's formal education includes a Bachelor of Arts degree (magna cum laude) in Fine Arts from the University of Florida (UF) with a second B.A. (summa cum laude) in Graphic Design from UF.

She is well-versed in many software applications including: QuarkXPress; Adobe PhotoShop / Illustrator / GoLive / Acrobat; Microsoft PowerPoint / Word; and FileMaker Pro. She designed and constructed the Diversity ArtWorks!™ website.

Personal Message

Art has always been an integral part of my life. In the beginning, there was my abstract, finger-painting phase. Needing structure, I moved on to paint-by-numbers, but soon cast aside the tyranny of 'stay-inside-the-line.' I discovered freehand painting and suddenly there were big-eyed cats in alleyways to conquer. Years later, extra-curricular hours were spent with my talented sister making clay creations in one class, and creating pastel portraits and oil/acrylic still-life fruit compositions in another. With junior college under my belt, I moved to Germany and found myself managing an arts and crafts shop: leatherwork, woodwork, jewelry, ceramics, and more. Then I was homeward bound and off to college for pottery, printmaking, art history and graphic design. Today, it's classes and workshops on the latest tools in the computerized world of graphic arts.

Leslie is a speaker, author, and workshop facilitator in the areas of Diversity, Cultural Competence, Communication, and Service Success in a Diverse World. In 1992, she founded International Training and Development, LLC, in Orlando, Florida. Her firm works with leading organizations to help them tap the strength of a diverse workforce and provide exceptional service for multicultural and international customers.

Leslie is author of two books: [Multicultural Customer Service: Providing Outstanding Service Across Cultures](#), McGraw Hill / Irwin, 1996; and [Ouch! That Stereotype Hurts](#), Walk the Talk Company, 2006. She co-produced the training video [Service Savvy: Providing Outstanding Service in a Diverse World](#), 2004. Leslie has developed three diversity/inclusion instruments: *DiversiScan™: Scanning the Environment for Diversity-Related Issues and Opportunities*; *Diversity Leadership 360™*; and *Diversity Competencies Assessment™*. She is also co-founder of Diversity ArtWorks!™

Previously Leslie spent 15 years with The Disney Company. Her Disney experience included bilingual guest services, new project development, Disney University training and development for expatriate and international staff, and human resources and administration for Disneyland Paris. She has also instructed ESOL courses (English for Speakers of Other Languages) within a business environment and served as student advisor for an international school.

Leslie currently serves on the National Workplace Diversity Panel - Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM). She is past-chair of the American Society for Training and Development (ASTD) Central Florida Chapter Diversity Council.

Leslie's educational background is in foreign language. She was educated at the University of Valencia, Spain; the North American Cultural Institute, Guadalajara, Mexico; the University of Paris IV (Sorbonne), France; and Stetson University, Florida. She also studied at the University of Geneva, Switzerland, as a Rotary International Scholar.

My interest in diversity began as a teenager when I first studied another language. Over the years, being trilingual opened doors to fascinating international and multicultural projects, people and places. When I began consulting in 1992, my interests expanded from cultural and ethnic diversity to all types of similarities and differences between people - be it gender, age, religion, sexual orientation, behavioral style, or more.

I believe that diversity of experiences and ideas brings innovation and creativity to the workplace and richness to our lives. I would like to see inclusion and respect as the norm in our society, workplace and world. One small way to bring diversity and inclusion concepts to life is through art, which is why graphic artist Judy Leslie and I have formed Diversity ArtWorks!
